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Use Agreement for Electronic Information Resources

Each student who utilizes the school's computer system and other school electronic devices will be assigned a user names and password instructed in the proper use of the network, students in 4th – 8th grade, will be assigned their own saintjameschool.net email address. The student and his/her parent or guardian must read and sign this use agreement before the student will be allowed to use the school's computer system and electronic information

The use of the school's computer system and electronic information resources must be in support of education and research, consistent with the educational objectives of the school. Students using the school's network or computing resources must comply with the appropriate rules for that network or resource.

I agree to follow the rules in all of my work with Saint James School's computers while attending Saint James School:

1. I will not use the computer resources for non-academic purposes. I will not waste or take supplies such as paper that are provided by the school. I will keep my computer work area clean and will not eat or drink in the computer lab or any electronic devices.
2. I will not make unauthorized copies of software, and I will not give, lend, or sell copies of software to others. I understand that I will not be allowed to bring software applications, games, CD-ROMs or flash drives from home to be used on school equipment without proof of licensure and prior approval of appropriate school personnel.
I will not copy, change, read, or use files from another user without prior permission from that user. I will not attempt to gain unauthorized access to the school's system programs for computer equipment.
3. I will not do anything that may disrupt or damage the school's computer system or electronic resources. I will not bring in, or allow access to, materials or websites that I believe may contain viruses, trojans or malware.
4. I will not use the school's computer systems and electronic resources to disturb or harass other computer users or use inappropriate language in my communications. I will not use obscene, lewd, vulgar, inflammatory, threatening, or disrespectful language when using the school's computer systems and electronic resources.
5. I will not harass or bully other individuals online or while texting. I will not use technology to spread falsehoods or defamatory statements in or out of school.
6. I will promptly disclose to my parent, teacher, or other school official any messages I receive or view which I feel are inappropriate or which make me feel uncomfortable.
7. I will not agree to meet anyone that I have met online without my parents' permission.
8. I will not use the school's computer system or electronic resources to engage in any illegal act.

10. I will honor my school's procedures for the storage of information. I realize that after prior notice has been given to me, files may be deleted from the system to protect the integrity of the network or because of space limitations.

11. I will not use bulletin boards, chat rooms, or social networks for personal use when using Saint James School's computers.
12. I will not reveal my personal information, username, password, home address, or personal phone number or those of students, teachers, or other staff members. Transmission of any material in violation of any U.S. or state regulation is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to: copyrighted material, threatening or obscene material, or material protected by trade secret. The use of school computers and networking resources for commercial activities is not permitted. Their use for product advertisement or political lobbying is also prohibited.
13. I understand that I have no expectation of privacy in my use of school computers. I understand that school officials may search and examine my use of school computers at any time, and without notice and my computer use is monitored.
14. While the school employs an enterprise-wide content filtration system and security software, parents must realize that their child may encounter material on a network/bulletin board that they do not consider appropriate (i.e., vulgar jokes, statements of belief that some might consider immoral, etc.). The student is responsible for not pursuing material that could be considered offensive.
15. The use of the computer is a privilege, not a right, and inappropriate use will result in the cancellation of these privileges. Vandalism or intentional modification of system settings will result in cancellation of privileges and/or school disciplinary action. Harassing or bullying other individuals online or while texting will result in cancellation of privileges and/or school disciplinary action. The school reserves the right to seek financial restitution for any damage caused by a student or other user. The system administrators will deem what is inappropriate use, and their decision is final. The administration, faculty, and staff of the school may request that the system administrator deny, revoke, or suspend specific user privileges. Violations of the rules and code of ethics described above will be dealt with seriously.
