



Saint James School 2026 Soccer Season

It's time to sign up for our school's soccer program!

Boys and Girls from grades three through eight are eligible to play. The league is co-ed and all levels of players are welcome. The season will run from early April through mid-June (Weather permitting!). Practices will likely be on Wednesday afternoons/evenings again – starting at Star Hill in Tolland and later moving to the outdoor fields at Martin School in Manchester. Practices will usually last about 90 minutes. Junior Varsity practices (third through fifth grades) are from 5:00pm – 6:30pm and Varsity Practices (sixth through eighth grades) are from 6:00pm - 7:30pm. Games are usually held in Manchester, on Saturdays between 8:00am and 2:00pm. Friday evening games may be held for Varsity if needed.

There is a \$60.00 fee per child to participate. There will be a discount for multiple players in the same family, two children \$100.00, three or more children \$120.00. Please make checks out to Saint Teresa of Calcutta Parish (note SJS Soccer in the memo field).

We participate in the Connecticut Catholic School Soccer League. There are a few simple rules in the league:

- This is a limited contact league, aggressive play is not tolerated
- We stress good sportsmanship
- All players are required to wear shin guards
- Cleats are optional but if worn, only plastic cleats are acceptable
- No jewelry may be worn during the games (This includes pierced earrings)
- We try to assure equal playing time for all participants

Prior to being able to participate in practice and games, students must submit **the 2026-2027 Athletics Health Permission Form** (signed by their doctor) to the main office. If this form was already submitted for another sport, you do NOT need to provide a new copy. Please complete the attached registration/contact form and return it to the school along with the fee and Athletics Health Form (if needed) by **Friday, March 20th**.

The first practice/game will be dependent upon the weather and the town of Manchester releasing the fields.
